



Graduate Certificate of Advanced Clinical Nursing (Paediatrics)

Monash Health is introducing an exciting new postgraduate course in partnership with Monash University.

The *Graduate Certificate of Advanced Clinical Nursing* is designed to meet the educational needs of registered nurses wishing to undertake specialist paediatric training.

The course combines theory and clinical practice with the aim of cultivating excellence in the provision of care to sick babies, children and young adults, within a family-centred care framework.

Successful graduates are prepared for practice as specialist paediatric nurses within multidisciplinary healthcare teams and within their chosen paediatric specialty field.

Specialty streams

- General paediatrics
- Paediatric emergency
- Paediatric intensive care

Eligibility

You must be a registered nurse employed in one of the three specialty streams. Places will be limited, applicants accepted subject to successful interview.

Course duration

12 months - 0.8 EFT

Course mode

Combination of online study, face-to-face learning and practical application and assessment.

Study days

Eight study days and one exam day, all based at Monash Children's Hospital.

Course starts – November 2017
Course concludes – October 2018

Fees

Monash Health will cover the cost of the subject conducted at Monash Children's Hospital. Standard fees apply for remaining two Monash University subjects.
