Referrals are accepted up to a child's 16th birthday

Existing patients with complex care needs

Referrals are accepted up to a child's 18th birthday (patients are usually transitioned to adult services by this time)

This service is available to children living in Victoria

Epilepsy

Neuromuscular disease

PRIORITY

All referrals received are triaged by Monash Health clinicians to determine urgency of referral.

EMERGENCY

For emergency cases please do any of the following:

- send the patient to the Emergency department OR
- Contact the on call registrar OR
- Phone 000 to arrange immediate transfer to ED

URGENT

The patient has a condition that has the potential to deteriorate quickly with significant consequences for health and quality of life if not managed promptly.

ROUTINE

The patient's condition is unlikely to deteriorate quickly or have significant consequences for the person's health and quality of life if the specialist assessment is delayed beyond one month
