

School Camps

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It is important to plan for school camps and consider the following:

- Parents/Carers need to be informed of any school camps at the beginning of the year.
- A separate and specific **Diabetes Camp Management Plan** is required and must be requested by the parents/carers at least 4 – 6 weeks prior to the camp.
- Parents/carers will need a copy of the camp menu and activity schedule.
- If the camp is located more than 30 minutes from a reliable ambulance service, Glucagon Injection training will be required for school staff.
- School staff will need to discuss any training needs at least 4-6 weeks before the camp with the student's parents/carers or Diabetes Treating Team.
