### Diabetes action and management plans

All children/students with type 1 diabetes attending early childhood settings, primary or secondary schools in Victoria need have a current Diabetes Action and Management plan in place to ensure that their diabetes care needs are supported and met.

These Diabetes Action and Management Plans have been developed by Diabetes Victoria, in conjunction with Royal Children's Hospital and Monash Children's Hospital diabetes treating teams. The plans are based on current best practice paediatric guidelines and are reviewed annually.

The plans need to be discussed, completed and signed by the child/student's diabetes treating team, parents/carers and either early childhood or school representatives.

### Diabetes in Schools Program

The Diabetes in Schools program encourages families, schools and health professionals to work together to support students to manage their Type 1 diabetes at schools. This program is funded by the Australian Government through the National Diabetes Service Scheme (NDSS).

This program includes an individualised skills training which involves practical, face to face training for designated school staff that focuses on the individual student's diabetes management.

This training is delivered to the school by a qualified healthcare professional.
